January 16, Minneapolis, Minn. McClellan Paper Co. and Minneapolis Drug Co. . Third street and First avenue, North; 6-story and basement brick building; protected by automatics sprinklers; low pressure alarm received at 2: 19 a. m. by central office; watchman in drug warehouse heard sprinkler bell ring, but before he could turn in an alarm the fire department and salvage corps arrived; fire in basement of paper house; entrance to paper warehouse gained by breaking open door; fire spread to second story; 27 sprinklers operated, emptying the tank; finally extinguished with chemical streams. Sprinkler protection restored at 1: 58 p. m. , January 16; central office men remained on premises until 7 a. m. , at which time communication was secured with sprhikler company and a request was made to restore sprinkler service.
