Physiological processes are fully explained, and complex subjects are approached through the gradual introduction of simple drawings. The authors employ a logical and consistent use of color to convey information; for example, arterial blood is always red, whereas venous blood is blue, and capillary blood is violet. Each lesson includes clearly displayed labels and specific coloring instructions. This book is an invaluable and lasting resource for students in disciplines including anatomy and physiology, biology, nursing, physical therapy and rehabilitation, medical technology, nutrition, physical education, allied health and health sciences.
